
While there are other search engines Google has become the default tool of choice. This powerful search engine allows the user to search for **images or pages**. In its basic form, the user enters a keyword and a search is returned. However, the Advanced search option allows you to quickly refine the search using Boolean Logic (And, Or, Not) fields as well as defining date ranges, file formats, language preferences etc

Process: 1. Open Browser and goto Google . 2. Select Advanced Search. 3. Enter keywords. 4.Refine search and bookmark suitable results.

Searching covers several taxonomic levels.



The **Advanced search options** (See Above) allow you to quickly refine the search and make the result managable and specific. The students must has developed a level of understanding of the topic to be able to refine and modify the search.
