- 4. What can you tell about Marcus's family so far?

Read to page 9

- 5. Summarise the main events that have occurred so far.
- 6. Why do you think that the people were not too concerned about the earth tremors and the wells drying up?
- 7. What is a mosaic?

Read to page 14

- 8. Summarise this chapter in your own words
- 9. Why do you think everything was so quiet in Pompeii before the earthquake?

Read to page 18

- 10. Do you believe the things that Cornus is telling Marcus? Why/Why not?
- 11. Do you think that chapter 5 has a good title? Explain your answer.
- 12. What would you do if you were Marcus's family? Why?

Read to page 29

- 13. Summarise the main event that occurred.
- 14. Which do you think caused more damage, the lava and burning rocks or the ash? Explain your answer.

Read to the end of the book

- 15. Do you think this book is fiction or non fiction? Explain your answer.
- 16. Write a newspaper account about how the dog survived and was found.
