4. Read the *Mouse Game*. Use a computer (or books) and read about a variety of string games or tricks. Try some. Record in your book at least **one** of these (how to complete it).
5. Design a game that can be played inside. You will need to set it out like those in the book with 'What You Need' and 'How to Play'. Ensure that your game has a name is carefully presented.
6. Play the '*Stick Game*' with a partner. Create a new pattern or rhythm and teach it to another group.
