

Library Book Dust Cover

The Task:

"You are an illustrator for a very famous company. An author has approached you as she is unhappy about the present design cover for her newest book. Your task is to design a creative/imaginative/interesting book cover that truly represents what the book is about, so that readers feel interested enough to buy/read the book."

Choose a book that you have enjoyed or would like to read. Create a new dust cover, include front and back cover including blurb and author bio. This is to be completed on A3 paper, landscape. The book can be fiction or non-fiction.

Additional Information:

The **dust cover** (sometimes **book jacket**, **dust wrapper** or **dust jacket**) of a book is the removable outer cover, usually made of paper and printed with text and illustrations. This outer cover has folded flaps that hold it to the front and back book covers. Often the back panel or flaps are printed with biographical information about the author, a summary of the book from the publisher (known as a blurb) or critical praise from celebrities or authorities in the book's subject area.
