Step 1

- 1. Open Photo Story
- 2. Select 'Begin a new story' and click Next

Step 2 Importing Images

Things that you can do: Import images, remove black borders, rotate images and simple photo editing

Click Import Pictures. Locate the folder that contains the photo or picture that you want to use.
 Click on the first image and click OK. To select all images hold 'Shift', click on the first and last image. To selectively pick images hold 'Control' and click on the images that you require.



4. Edit images as required and click Next




Step 3 Add a Title

- 1. Click on the image that you want to add text to.
- 2. Type the text and arrange the text to suit by clicking



3. Change the appearance of the image if required by clicking *Effect*



Step 4 Adding Narration / Customising Motion

Narration can be added to individual images if a microphone is attached. Transitions, zooms, and timings can be changed.

- To add a narration, see separate notes.
- 1. To customise motion, click the image you want to work with
- 2. Click Customise Motion
- 3. Set the time you want the image to appear for
- 4. Select a transition if required
- 5. Move to the next image



Step 5 Add Background Music

Either select music from your computer (not all music formats are supported) or create your own

- 1. Click Select Music or *Create Music*
- 2. Select the options that you require and listen to your composition
- 3. Click OK

- 2. Select the settings for your movie (For normal playback the default settings are fine)
- 3. Click *Next* and Photo Story creates your movie
- 4. Click *View your story*
