SPEECH STRUCTURE

Writing your speech

Introduction BEFORE HE SPEAKS

- Grab the audience attention Grabber (Might be a question, statement or joke)
- Greeting formal or informal
- Statement about your topic
- Say the three four main points you are going to cover in one sentence.

Body

- 3-4 Main points to speak about
- Back up main points

Conclusion

- Summary of main points in one sentence
- Leave the audience with something to remember
- Conclude what you think ties to introduction

Speeches are written like a Hamburger;
Top layer (Bun) = appetising introduction
Middle Layers (Fillings) = ideas /main points
Bottom layer (Bun) = conclusion, holds everything together.
