Writing your speech

## A WISE PERSON THINKS BEFORE HE SPEAKS

### Introduction

- Grab the audience attention – Grabber (Might be a question, statement or joke)
- Greeting – formal or informal
- Statement about your topic
- Say the three - four main points you are going to cover – in one sentence.

### Body

- 3-4 Main points to speak about
- Back up main points

### Conclusion

- Summary of main points – in one sentence
- Leave the audience with something to remember
- Conclude what you think – ties to introduction

Speeches are written like a Hamburger;  
Top layer (Bun) = appetising introduction  
Middle Layers (Fillings) = ideas /main points  
Bottom layer (Bun) = conclusion, holds everything together.
