## The Treasure Hunt

(Based on the ReadWorks Text)

Yesterday you read a text from ReadWorks about children creating a treasure hunt for a party.

Today, your task is to create your own (virtual) treasure hunt. You must start by

- 1. Deciding where your treasure hunt will be (around home, school, neighbourhood)
- 2. Writing some creative clues. There should be between 5-10 clues. An example could be;

Things go inside me when dirty but come out clean.

You will find me standing sturdy next to my mate.

Answer: Washing Machine

- 3. Create a map of your area, as accurately as possible.
- 4. Think about what your 'treasure' would be.
- 5. If possible (if it is around the house or section), try it with a family member.

You will probably need to complete this on pieces of paper or in a book. You can take photos of your map and clues (plus 'action shots' of people trying to find your treasure if you do this). These photos could possibly be put together in google slides and shared with Mr C.

This activity will likely take a few days, aim to complete it by the end of the week.
